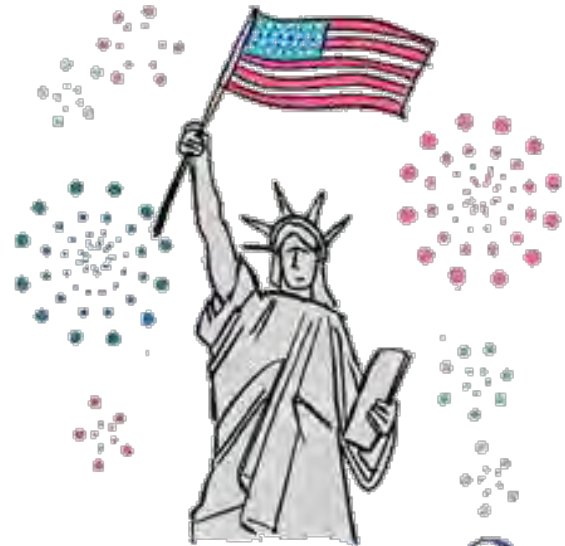

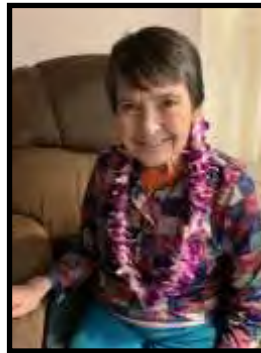
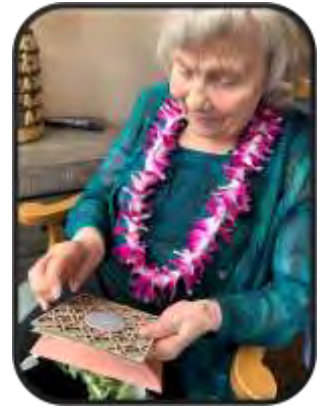
Susan Beebe and Tess Holden have accepted full time ALA positions to join the nursing team in doing direct care! Congratulations and welcome!

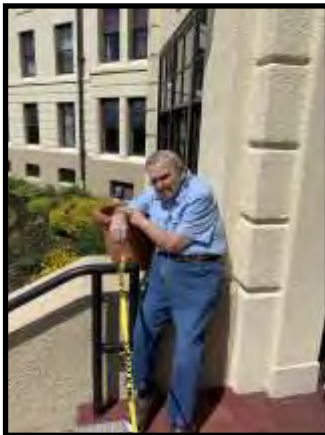

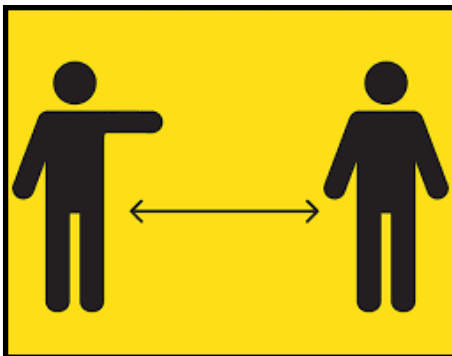


Spring and Summer warmth has us all yearning to be outside...so we find ways!
