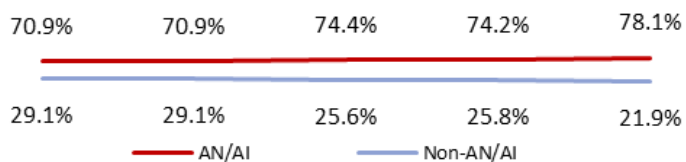

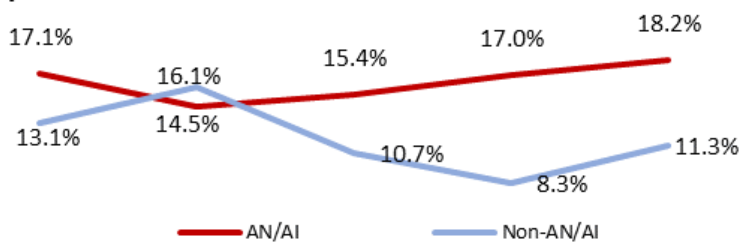

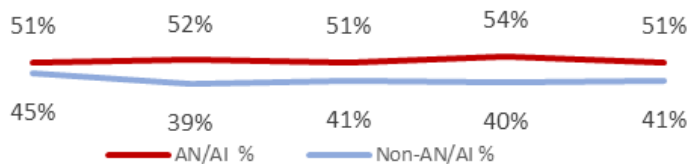

Extended Family Placements



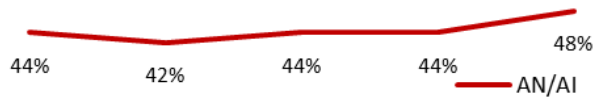

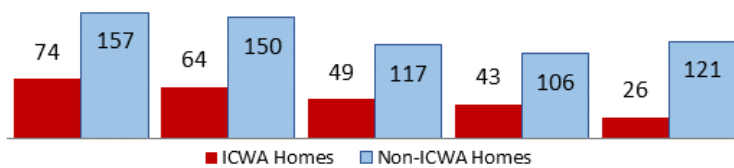

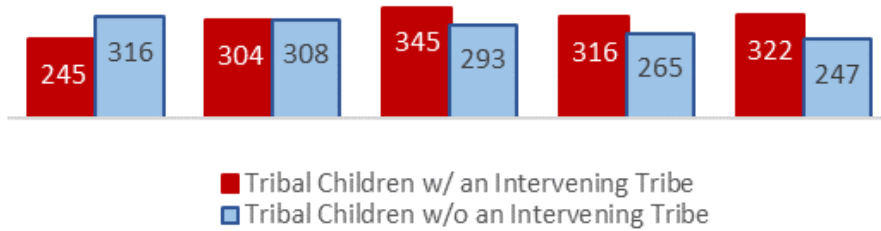

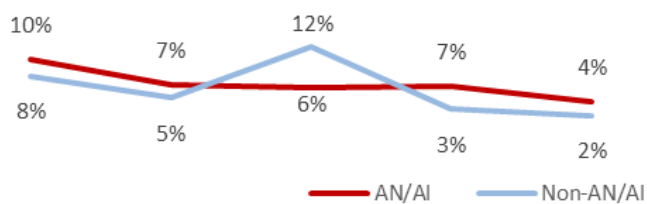

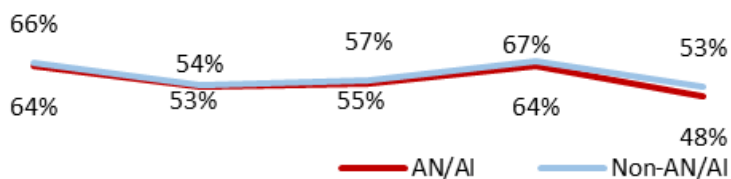

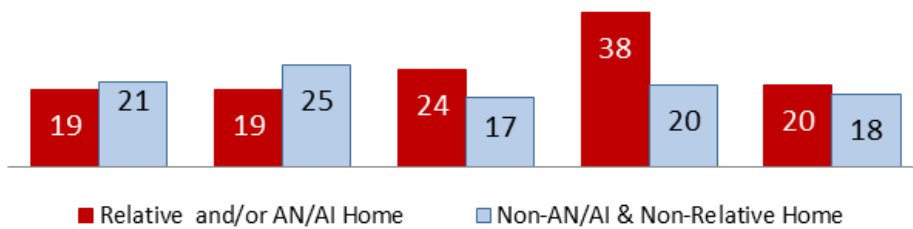

Notes:

Example: **2021 Alaska Native/American Indian statewide child population was 27.9%; 2022 Alaska Native/American Indian in Office of Children's Services Out of Home care was 64.8%**

Interpretation: **In 2021 28.2% of the 0-17 Alaska child population were Alaska Native/American Indian children; in 2022 64.9% of children in Statewide Office of Children's Services Out of Home Care were Alaska Native/American Indian.**

Example: **2021 Alaska Native/American Indian Anchorage Regional Office child population was 19.2%; 2022 Alaska Native/American Indian in Anchorage Regional Office Out of Home Care was 62.9%**

Interpretation: **In 2021 19.2% of the 0-17 Anchorage Regional Office child population were Alaska Native/American Indian children; in 2022 62.9% of children in Anchorage Regional Office/ Office of Children's Services Out of Home care were Alaska Native/American Indian.**

Alaska Native/American Indian Children in Out of Home Care represents Alaska Native/American Indian children who were in OUT OF HOME care sometime during the calendar year, children are considered in OUT OF HOME care from the date of removal until discharged regardless of placement setting.

***Maltreatment & Repeat Maltreatment:** Numbers/rates may be impacted by data latency.

Maltreatment: count of children with substantiated maltreatment in investigations completed during the reporting period.

Repeat Maltreatment: Repeat victims are those with a previous substantiated allegation within the prior 12 months.

Placement data is point time December 31.

Extended Family Placement: Preference 1 placements.

Indian Child Welfare Foster Homes data is point in time December 31.

Tribal Intervention: Represents the number of children who had an intervention during the reporting year. If intervention occurred after the reporting period, it is not included in this number. Children in non-intervening Tribes includes all Alaska Native/American Indian children who do not have a Tribal affiliation listed in ORCA.

Re-Entry into Care: Children removed from home during the reporting period who have a discharge within the 12 months prior to their most recent reporting period removal date.

Reunification: Total based on number of children discharged with an end reason of reunification and children on a trial home visit over 180 days or expired. 2023 totals may change slightly due to data latency entry.

Children Exiting to Adoption or Guardianship: 2023 totals may change slightly due to data latency entry.
