

Alaska Office of Children's Services - Statistics for the Month of May 2022

This page includes statistics divided into the following four categories:

Protective Service Reports

1,638 Protective Service Reports were screened:

- 491 were screened in,
- 1,147 were screened out.

Initial Assessments

496 Initial Assessments were completed:

- 126 were Substantiated,
- 349 were Not Substantiated,
- 28 were Closed Without a Finding.

Out-of-Home Care

Please note that due to administrative processing, there may be a significant lag for entry of discharge data into ORCA, which may affect reporting accuracy for recent periods.

2,977 children were in an Out-of-Home care (1,991 of these were Alaskan Native/American Indian):

- 90 children were removed from their home (70 of these were AN/AI),
- 93 children were discharged from Out-of-Home care (61 of these were AN/AI).

Licensed Providers. ICWA homes meet the standard for the Indian Child Welfare Act.

1,469 total Licensed Providers were made up of the following types:

- 615 Non-Child-Specific Foster Homes (101 of which were ICWA),
- 582 Child-Specific Foster Homes,
- 162 Non-Child-Specific Foster Group Homes (23 of which were ICWA),
- 47 Child-Specific Foster Group Homes,
- 17 Child Placement Agencies,
- 38 Residential Child Care Facilities,
- 6 Residential Psychiatric Treatment Centers,
- 2 Maternity Homes,
- 0 Tribal Foster Homes,
- 0 Independent Living Programs,
- 0 Assisted Living Facilities.
